



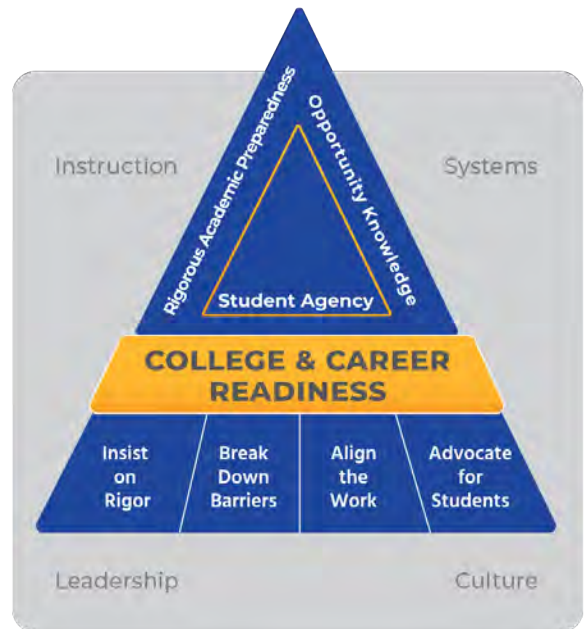
AVID's mission is to close the opportunity gap by preparing all students for college readiness and success in a global society.

What is AVID?

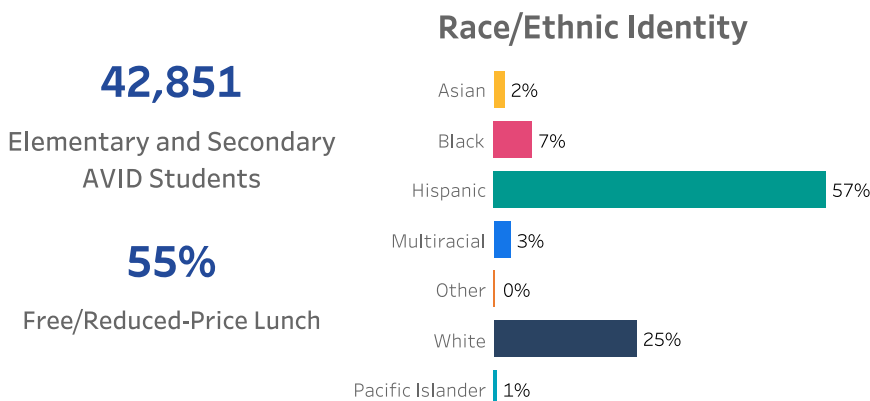
- Advancement Via Individual Determination
